Everyone is struggling in the Lewis-Clark Valley in the current economy. We know you are all having trouble making ends meet, but the Lodge is struggling also. The Lodge needs help. By stopping in a little more often, coming to a dance, buying a couple more drinks, bottled water or a dinner, you could really help. Most members don't realize that our Avista bill can be over \$1500 a month, Sales Tax, Business and Occupation taxes are \$1500 to \$2000 a month. Salaries are \$6000 a month. Property taxes a year run \$10,000. Moose International payments run \$10,000 a year. Risk Pool \$10,000 a year, and various other licensing fees, supplies, phone, sewer, music, etc., add into the equation.

We need more volunteers! Please if you can find some time to help us out, please talk to any of your officers. There are many areas in which you could help. The kitchen teams would like some more people to help with meals. The more people available to help with a meal once in a while, can give these team members a night off.

Kudos to all the members who have stepped up to do all the planning, cooking and cleaning after the dinners and funerals. If you haven't tried some of the new dinners, come take a look.
