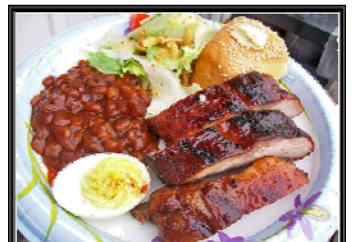

Book Your Parties Now!!!!

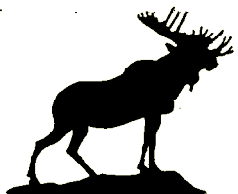
